#### Ladder's and Letter of Interpretation

The Federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has issued a letter of interpretation regarding fixed ladders covered under OSHA's General Industry Walking-Working Surfaces Standard. Included in the letter is information on measurement of fall distances, rest platforms and fixed ladders used for escape by employees.

#### Safe Kids Minnesota
