Secretary's Report

Scott will propose to hold over the profit funds in the NW Chapter financial account to be made available for the 2020 boat cruise.

Chair Reporting

Nominations and Elections: No Report

Dec. – Emerging Trends in Absence Management presented by Christina Bergman, AON. Event and details will be posted shortly.

January – Joint meeting ASSP/AIHA. Wildland fire fighting and the updated federal fit testing protocol are being considered. Other topics are still being considered. Scott Huberty offered a potential topic of Metro Airport Commission and a day in the life of MSP or a similar topic. Feb – PDC.

March (Team Approach) –Janie Ritter is taking the lead to secure topic/speaker and is targeting the Superior Fire and Police Chief's presentation around the Husky Oil event that has been well received by Safety Council members in the past.

April – 3M Red Wing will Host. Topic remains as Confined Space Entry and Gas Detection.



May –PDR Clinics is confirmed to host the session at their Edina location but will not be providing speaker. An opportunity will be given to conduct a short tour, outside of the formal Chapter meeting. PDR is asking for more input on how to tailor presentations to the Chapter members and what would be suggested for topics of interest (i.e. implications of an aging workforce and return to work).

Other –Abby Ferri reported that Deb Hillmerson offered to be a sponsor for the December Chapter meeting.

Student Sections: UMD section provided a written report. Hunt Electrical and TSI presented to the UMD student section. MSA did a technical talk on monitoring equipment and the students have been engaging in other safety related tours. Two UMD students attended the ASSP Future Leadership conference.

PDC Committee: Chris Flegel reporting. There continues to be a need for session speakers, sponsors and vendors. The committee needs help from the Board to increase awareness about the PDC and requests additional written and social media communications. David Abrams volunteered to write a PDC newsletter article. Discussion held on identifying a theme for the PDC to improve marketing communications. The keynote speaker for the PDC has been secured. Committee is considering a change in the stage set-up in the main presentation room. Retaining the music during the event is seen as a benefit.

The PDC committee is in conversations with Vivid Learning Systems, an on-line safety training company. Jill James of Vivid Learning Systems, produces a podcast called "The Accidental Safety Pro". The podcast is focused on telling safety professional's stories on how they got into the safety profession. Jill did some "on the scene" interviews with safety professionals at the recent National Safety Council conference gathering their stories on how they entered the safety profession. She is interested in being at the Northwest Chapter PDC and arranging for similar type of interviews with safety professionals attending the PDC. Scott Huberty and Chris Flegel are working with Vivid Learning on the details and how this type of event might benefit the NW Chapter.

New Business

• New Name Tags –Board name tags were ordered and made available by Chris Flegel. It was noted that they were printed with the ASSP logo instead of the Chapter logo and may be replaced.



- Kurt VonRueden attended the MN Safety Council quarterly board meeting. Kurt will prepare a short newsletter item on the board meeting.
- David Abrams requested input on whether or not the Northwest Chapter of ASSP would be willing to support the Loppet Foundation with a donation for the purchase of bike helmets for underserved children in north Minneapolis.
- Chris Flegel requested board support to pay for early registration fee for a booth at the West River Safety Days in Rapid City, SD in April of 202. Abby Ferri made a motion to provide registration fee for Chris Flegel register a booth on behalf of the Northwest Chapter for April 2020. John Breskey seconded the motion. Motion was offered for vote and was passed unanimously.
