Treasurer Report:

- Chris F provided an overview on the December 31st, 2021 Treasurer Report
 - o Revenue of \$1,660 (dues \$1,310, meeting fees \$350)
 - Expenses of \$245.91 (other-speaker gifts \$50, 66 renewals \$132, bank fees \$28.91, web hosting \$35)
 - o Net income of \$1,414.09; bank balance \$43,682.98
 - Discussion took place on renewals and dues for the Chapter and how other Regions operate
 - Jenn C moved to approve the December 31st Treasure Report; Carol K seconded motion passed unanimously
- Upcoming expenses-travel to SD Safety Council, vendor at MN Safety Council PDC, travel to West River Safety Days

Previous Meeting Business:

- Jen E mentioned there was previous discussion around re-naming our Chapter we did not have time in January meeting and will discuss in February 2022 meeting
- Spring ROC will be held in Milwaukee, WI April 27-April 29
 - Face to face meeting expected but will have hybrid available

- Cary Swenson Memorial Scholarship Fund set-up and Northwest Chapter was contacted asking for support and donation
 - Janie R did not have conversation with ASSP Foundation, David Downs did, understanding is the amount of the scholarship is \$1,000/year at \$30,000 donation input and only had one option to designate that \$1,000 to and could not split it between different entities
 - Request likely for \$2,500-\$5,000 range for donation
 - Discussion on other grants sometimes propose multiple criteria in case there are multiple qualifying applicants and on the benefit of donating to ASSP directly versus to Cary Swenson Memorial Scholarship Fund
 - Scholarship would be managed through ASSP Foundation just under Cary Swenson's name; this was decided due to ASSP Foundation having expertise and an investment system already established
 - Janie R will follow up with David Downs to get additional information if we can open up scholarship to all schools within our Region versus limited to UMD
